Mission Statement: Seymour Extreme Dance Club will provide a safe and fun environment for the children of our community to learn and appreciate the love of dance in a cost effective way so we may reach as many members of our community as possible.

Participation in the club is subject to the observance of the clubs rules and procedures, which are listed below. Any club member including dancers, parents, committee members, or teachers who violates this Code is subject to the removal from this program. Removal of any dancers due to violating the Code will be **non-refundable**.

- Honesty and integrity are expected from all dancers and parents.
- Any complaints or concerns must be brought to the club's attention via club email seymourdance@gmail.com. When necessary, it will be brought to the club board members for resolution.
- Parents, teachers, dancers, committee members, and board members must demonstrate respect for each other at ALL times, including NO abusive language. If disrespectful behavior is shown, the family may be asked to leave the club.
- Absolutely no bullying, gossip, or isolation of other dancers.
- Everyone must treat the practice locations and possessions of all others with respect, care, and consideration.
- Parents and children waiting for their dancer(s) MUST be quiet and stay in the designated areas, and there will be NO running or yelling in the halls at any of our dance practice locations.
- Must arrive and be ready for class on time to avoid disruption to other dancers.
- Have appropriate dance attire on and be ready to dance. Attire must meet dress code (see dress code).
- Dancers are expected to focus and pay attention to the teacher's instructions and keep talking to a minimum. *Excessive talking or inattentive dancer's enrollment will be reviewed by the board after 3 occurrences.
- Regular attendance is a COMMITMENT to the other dancers in the class as well as the teachers in order for the class to complete their routines for recital. Absences MUST be reported via the Band app. *If dancers miss 4 classes, their enrollment will be reviewed by the board members.
- All are expected to clean up after themselves. The practice locations are a privilege given to us that can be taken away easily.
- Dancers, absolutely NO cell phones or other electronic devices are to be used during class times. If this is not followed, devices will be taken by teachers & returned at the end of class.
- Any unauthorized materials such as explosives, firearms, weapons, or other similar items are prohibited onto any dance locations.
- No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are allowed
